

PRIVACY POLICY

This document specifies and explains how the Website collects and uses the information that the User has chosen to share. By using the Website, the User accepts all practices described in the Privacy Policy.

The Owner of the Website reserves the right to change the content of the Privacy Policy at any time, but commits to notify Users in advance of planned changes. Information about changes in the Privacy Policy will be posted as a message on the main page of the Website. The current content of the Privacy Policy will be posted at this web address. Further use of the Website means agreeing to all terms and provisions contained in the new text.

The administrator of personal data is the Owner of the Website, iDevelopers s.r.o. company based in 821-07 BRATISLAVA, BUČINOVÁ 8698/2, Slovakia. The data are provided by the User voluntarily, e.g. during the Account Registration process, and are also collected automatically at a later time, while the User uses the Website. Before providing data, the User is asked to consent to their processing, which is implemented in the form of explicit confirmation. Personal data will be processed for the purpose of performing the contract concluded with the User, the possibility of providing services electronically, using the Website, as well as ensuring safety during use. We guarantee the fulfillment of all rights resulting from the general regulation on data protection, i.e. the right of access, rectification and deletion of data as well as the withdrawal of consent at any time. Lack of consent or its withdrawal, as well as deletion of data, will prevent the conclusion of the contract, the provision of services and the use of the Website, which is associated with the deletion of the existing User Account.

The User has the right to lodge a complaint in connection with the processing of personal data by us to the supervisory authority, which is Inšpektorát SOI pre Bratislavský kraj, Prievozská 32, P.O. Box 5, 820 07 Bratislava 27.

§ 1. Automatically collected data

During visits to the Website's websites, data related to the visit and interaction with the Website, such as IP address, domain name, browser type, and any other data required by current law, are automatically collected. This information is collected from all people using the Website, without exception. Additionally, information from cookies is collected.

§ 2. Cookies

Cookies are files storing data about the User, stored on the computer or other device of this User, which is used to connect to the Website. Cookies contain information about the session, domain name, validity period, unique number. They do not contain personal data.

The Website uses Cookies, which the user is informed about during the first visit to the site. The User has the possibility to consent to the use of Cookies, as well as to refuse such consent. The Website uses persistent Cookies to ensure the proper functioning of the Website and Services, e.g. to confirm whether the User is logged in. These Cookies will not be deleted after closing the browser. The User can delete or block such a Cookie using browser settings, however, this will cause the Website to malfunction. The User therefore makes such a decision at their own risk.

§ 3. Data collected during registration

To fully use the functions of the Website, the User can register. During Registration, such data as IP address, browser type, domain name are automatically collected. Other data is provided voluntarily by the User and includes email address, place of residence, gender, and date of birth.

Registration in the Website is subject to a one-time fee, which can be paid, among others, by sending a paid SMS text message. In this case, the payment operator provides the Website with the phone number from which the payment was made.

Consent to the processing of the provided personal data is required during Registration.

§ 4. Individuals under eighteen years of age

1. The Owner does not knowingly collect or demand personal information from any individual under the age of eighteen; nor does it allow such a person to Register.
2. If the User is under 18, they are not allowed to register with the Website or provide any information about themselves, including their name, address, telephone number, or email address.
3. No individual under the age of 18 can provide information to the Owner and Administrator, post it on the Website, or

transmit it in any way.

4. In the event that there is suspicion that collected information comes from or concerns a person under 18, it will be deleted as quickly as possible.
5. Any suspicion of individuals under 18 using the Website should be reported to the Administrator.

§ 5. Data collected during purchase transactions of Services and Credits

The Owner does not collect any User data during the purchase of Services in the Website and Credits. Such data may be collected by an external payment service. The only information passed on by the external payment service are the payment amount, type of service, and payment identifier. Information transferred by the external payment service is used to process the purchase transactions of Services and Credits.

§ 6. Data collected during order of credit withdrawal

When ordering a credit withdrawal in PLN (Polish Złotys), the User voluntarily provides personal data and account details, including name and surname, address, bank account number, and bank name. This information is necessary for the correct execution of the bank transfer and is stored for the period necessary to provide this service. All data is stored securely using appropriate data protection measures. In addition, based on the Act on Counteracting Money Laundering and Terrorism Financing, the User may be asked to confirm their identity based on a face photo with a visible identity document. Such a photo will be stored for the period of providing Services to the User in offline mode, using asymmetric encryption and other required security measures.

§ 7. Data collected during contact with the Website

When the User contacts the Website, they voluntarily provide an email address. The address is stored in order to enable a response to the inquiry.

§ 8. Data collected during the use of cameras

During the User's transmission of content via cameras, automatic copies of some, selective, frames of this transmission are made. These frames are used for the internal use of the Administrator.

§ 9. Data provided by the User

1. By using the Website, the User may Register and thus create an Account. Through it, the User can create their personal profile, establish relationships with other Users, send messages, search for information, create and participate in discussion groups, and transmit data and content in many other ways. When creating a profile, the User can provide various personal data such as name, height, weight, preferences, likes, photo. This information is provided voluntarily and is optional. Many of these details can be covered by privacy settings - the User decides to whom, or which group of recipients they will be displayed and disclosed.
2. The above-mentioned information is collected in order to provide the most suitable services and personalized functionalities. In most cases, they serve, for example, to display the list of a given User's messages, etc.
3. Profile Information is used by the Website primarily for its presentation and the ability for the User to edit it, and for presentation to other Users who have permission to view it. In some cases, if privacy settings allow it (e.g. commenting on the Profile), other Users may have the ability to influence some features of the User's Profile.
4. The User's Profile Information will be available to Users who belong to at least one group of people whom the User has allowed such access through privacy settings.
5. The Administrator may use information contained in the Profile, without specifying the User's person, by providing this information to third parties. This happens, for example, when wanting to determine the number of people who like a given photo or video. The data is used to analyze User behaviors on the Website's websites, collect demographic data, or to personalize the content of the Website's websites.
6. Some information may be visible in search results on the Website's pages and may be automatically shared with external search engines. People who are in no way related to the User can have access to these Profile data. The data shared in this way include, for example, profile name, age and place of residence, preferences, activity date, height, and Materials whose privacy settings allow it.
7. The User shares, sends, and transmits User Materials in the Website at their own risk. Despite the possibility of setting privacy options that limit access to them, the User must be aware that no security measures are perfect and

unbreakable. The Administrator does not have the ability to control the actions of other Users with whom the User has decided to share Data and Materials. Therefore, the Administrator does not ensure and does not guarantee that User Materials will not be viewed by unauthorized persons. The Administrator is not responsible for any circumvention of privacy settings or security measures applied in the Website. At the same time, the Administrator takes all possible actions to minimize these types of threats and takes all possible measures to protect the User's data.

8. The User understands and acknowledges that even after removal, copies of Materials, Content, and Data may still be available in the browser's temporary memory, on archived pages, or in the possession of Users who have copied or saved them.
9. By using the Website, certain information that the User provides, transmits or discloses to third parties (e.g. friends or someone in a discussion group, in a chat), such as personal data, comments, messages, photos, videos, or other information, may be shared with other Users based on selected privacy settings. The User carries out such an exchange of information at their own risk, bearing in mind that if they disclose personal data in their profile or share comments, messages, photos, videos or other materials, such information may be publicly available.
10. Any inappropriate collection or use of information is a violation of the Regulations and should be reported to the Administration via the contact form available in the Website panel.

§ 10. Data Use by the Website

1. The Website may occasionally use the User's profile name and email address to send notifications regarding the Websites, using standard methods implemented in the system. For instance, if another User sends a new message to the Account owner, or someone comments on a Material, the owner may receive an email notifying them of this fact. The User can disable receiving such notifications, but the Administrator reserves the right to send messages regarding the Account even despite disabling the possibility of their reception, especially in the case of detected problems, violations, important information or changes in the Website.
2. The Administrator and Owner do not disclose contact information to third parties without the User's consent, unless required by applicable law.
3. The Owner may be compelled to disclose information about the User to authorities, for instance, in the case of a court summons or complying with applicable regulations, including under Article 14, paragraph 5 of the Police Act. The Owner ensures that they do not disclose information until there is complete certainty that the request for its disclosure expressed by authorities or a private individual is legal. Additionally, the Owner may disclose information if they believe it is necessary under applicable law to protect interests or property, to prevent fraud or other illegal activities taking place through the use of the Website or using its name, or to prevent physical damage. This may include sharing information with other companies, lawyers, agents, or government agencies.
4. If the ownership rights to the Website, in whole or in part, held by the Owner change, User information will be passed on to the new owner. In any case of such a transfer of information, User information will still be subject to the current Privacy Policy.

§ 11. Changing or Deleting Information

Access to and control over most Data and Materials in the Website is possible through profile editing tools. The User can modify or delete any information, Data, Materials, at any time. Anyone wishing to delete their account in the Website can do so in the User account settings or by contacting the Administrator. The User can withdraw consent to the processing of personal data at any time, which is associated with deleting the account in the Website. Deleted information will remain in the form of a backup for as long as necessary under applicable law, but will not be available to Users. Choosing to use the communication methods available in the Website to send information to another person (e.g., by writing a private message), it is usually not possible to delete such communication. Nor is it possible to change or delete data collected automatically.

§ 12. Data Security

The Administrator takes all available precautions to protect the information, Data, and Materials of Users. They are placed on secure servers located behind a firewall. Databases are protected against access by third parties. All communication with the Website takes place via an encrypted SSL (Secure Socket Layer) connection, and all passwords are secured with the best available encryption method using a "salt", which prevents their reading.

As email messages are not considered a secure means of communication, we ask that you do not send us private information by email.

§ 13. Other Websites

The Website may contain links to other websites, including the store.zbiornik.com website. The Owner is in no way responsible for the rules prevailing on other sites. The User should familiarize themselves with the regulations and privacy policy of each site that collects information about its users. This Privacy Policy applies only to information collected by the Owner of the Website.
